### **Fire Safety Talk (video) / Internet Safety Talk (video)**

Compulsory talks about some of the safety measures in Peterhouse. We've scheduled these in for you, but they'll be sent out as videos so you can watch them in your own time

### **Student Union Introduction (video)**

Introductory video from the Student Union about how the SU works and what they provide for students

### **Mental Health Workshops**

Mental Health Workshops run by MIND that focus on how you can look after your wellbeing during university. Though these are red on the timetable and we strongly recommend you attend, you can opt-out if you do not feel comfortable attending these sessions. An email about the sessions, what session you are allocated to (and the subsequent zoom links) and how you can opt out will be sent to you.

### **Race Awareness / Anti-Racism Workshops**

Compulsory workshops focussing on how we can act in an Anti-Racist manner in a traditionally white atmosphere like Cambridge. These are run by our Ethnic Minority's Office, Rahul, over Zoom and you will be sent an email allocating you a session with the zoom information.

### **Alcohol Awareness Workshops**

Compulsory workshops promoting drinking in a responsible manner – please don't feel patronised by this! These are meant to inform you about how you can treat college property in a respectful way even when drunk and ensuring you keep yourself and your friends safe - they're in light of one too many chunders in college </3 You will be sent an email allocating you a session with the Zoom information.

### **Consent Workshops**

Compulsory workshops focussing on the importance of consent within relationships. Run by our Women and Marginalised Gender's Officer, George, over Zoom and you will be sent an email allocating you a session with the Zoom info.

### **Picnics**

Picnics in the Deer Park! You will be sent an email allocating you to a session and explaining how you can order your food requests via UPAY which will be provided by our catering team.

### **Zoom Lunch**

Every lunchtime we'll be running a Zoom session where you can check in with people and chat over lunch!

### **Fudge and Smoothies**

Fudge and smoothies provided in the marquee in the Deer Park, a great way to socialise with new people

### **Online Games**

Does what it says on the tin! You will be sent the zoom link prior to the event

### **Virtual Speed Dating**

Everyone's worst nightmare: Speed dating but via Zoom. Don't be put off though! We'll randomly allocate you into small breakout rooms and give you the opportunity to speak to people you may not have otherwise had the chance to meet!

### **Household Drinks**

### **Film Night**

### **Pizza and Cards Night**

These aren't really official sessions organised by the us, but rather an encouragement of you all to get together in your houses (in groups of no more than 6) and order pizza, drink coke (or something stronger if you're that way inclined ...) and play cards or just chat. Even if you don't have a session scheduled in the evening please socialise either inside or outside your houses – as long as you're socially-distanced and in groups of 6 or less.

### **Punting**

### **Online Pub Quiz**

AMALS stands for Amalgamated Clubs and Societies and is the committee in charge of all the extra-curricular events at Peterhouse. All the clubs and societies of Peterhouse have pre-recorded videos telling you about themselves and how you can join – essential viewing if you're looking to get involved!

### **Matriculation**
